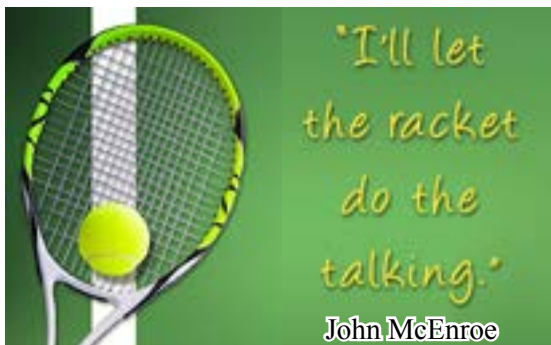

Aerification

I would like to begin by dispelling any myths about golf course superintendents enjoying aerification and the resulting interruption to play. The Club's commitment to aerification is one of the primary reasons we were able to maintain our playing conditions on some of the oldest greens in the area through the most difficult winter in the last 75 years. Aerification occurs during the summer months primarily because of the turf's ability to recover from it during warmer growing conditions and has less to do with the snowbirds leaving than one might think. Double cutting, height of cut reductions, and rolling all result in high green speeds and aerification removes the resulting compaction giving the turf a chance to breathe again. Summer aerification also removes the organic matter resulting from a season worth of growth. This is important because organic matter clogs the pores where the soil would hold water, nutrients, and air which the turf draws upon through the root system for survival. Aerification will remain an important focus of our summer with 3 aerifications scheduled for greens and two scheduled for all other playing surfaces. For those of you who will be with us though the summer, we thank you all for your patience while we complete these vital practices. For those of you who have returned north for the summer, apply that same patience to your superintendent when he aerifies your perfectly good greens in September/October.

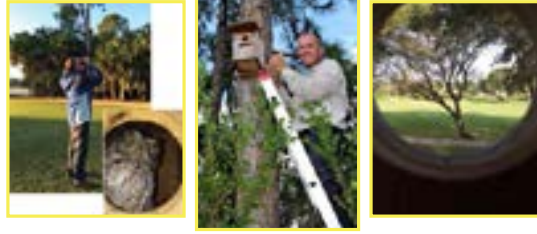
